



Please find below a list of words for each year group that will be taught as part of our 'Relationships. Sex, Health Education curriculum'. Please be aware this list is not exhaustive and other vocabulary may be used by pupils, that will be explained by staff as appropriate.

Relationship Vocabulary for each year group

Nursery/Reception

Private parts, dress, undress, clean, smelly, flannel, sponge, towel, hands, toothpaste, hairbrush, comb, family, mum, dad, brother, sister, grandma, granddad, step mum, stepdad

Year 1

Private parts, clean, similar, different, family, boy, girl, male, female, private parts

Year 2

Private parts, penis, vagina, similar, different, gender roles, stereotypes, boy, girl, female, male

Year 3

Private parts, penis, testicles, vagina, womb, stereotypes, gender roles, similar, different, male, female, family, fostering, adoption, relationship

Year 4

Puberty, lifecycle, reproduction, physical changes, breasts, sperm, egg, pubic hair, emotional, feelings

Year 5

Puberty, physical changes, emotional changes, moods, menstruation, periods, tampons, sanitary towels, wet dreams, semen, erection, sweat, breasts, spots, pubic hair, facial hair, underarm hair, feelings

Year 6

Womb, sperm, egg, conception, fertilisation, pregnancy, sexual intercourse, twins, fostering, relationships, friendship, love, consent, intimacy, communication, personal/private information, internet safety
