Lancashire Schools Game Baton Relay

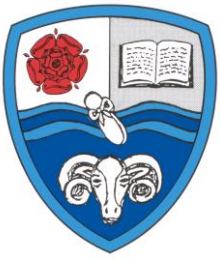
Today we received the Lancashire Schools Game Baton that is being transported by pupils across schools in Lancashire in preparation for the Commonwealth Games this summer.
