Maths

Key Vocabulary: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, one, two, three, four, five, how many, count, counting, forwards, backwards, order.

Phonics

We have continued our phase 2 phonics.

Our new phonemes (sounds) this week are:

ck, e, u, r

We have been practising how to write the graphemes (letters) using the correct letter formation.

Can your children find objects with the sounds **ck**, **e**, **u**, **r**. If so, please send pictures to me over Class Dojo. The children can share this with their friends.

Our core text this week was:




