
Hello everyone!

Maths

This week we have been recapping our knowledge of counting numbers 1-5. The children have been looking at the conservation of number, for example the quantity three, is always three no matter how it is arranged.



Key Vocabulary: Compare, order, more, fewer, one, two, three, four, five, represent, match, equal, less than, more than, fewer than, same, different.

Home learning: Can you encourage your children to engage in counting throughout daily activities. For example, how many teddies? How many eggs? How many people are here? Are there more bananas or more apples?

Our core text this week was:



This week we have been listening to different versions of the traditional tale. We have been discussing the similarities, differences, and our favourite versions.

The children have also been thinking about bonfire safety, learning a new song on how to keep safe, whilst creating different types of bonfire night pictures.

We have learnt all our phase 2 phonemes and graphemes.




The children are doing well with their phonics.
