Maths


We have been focusing on understanding positional language.

The children have experienced seeing things from different perspectives and describing relative positions.

Home learning: Plenty of experience with construction equipment, jigsaws, following routes indoors and outdoors and searching for hidden objects by following instructions will all help to develop their spatial awareness.

Phonics

We have consolidated our learning of phase 2. In the new year we will begin phase 3.



Home learning:

- Your child is bringing home a word book. Inside the word book includes the phase 2 tricky words. Children need to know that you cannot sound out the tricky words and we need to recognise them.
- Tricky words: to, the, no, go, her, into, **I**.
- Please read with your children at home, encouraging them to say the sounds and blend ("squash") the sounds together to read the word.
- Continue to use the fine motor skills activities (provided at parents evening) to develop strength in hands and support children's writing.
