Hello everyone!

Reception have had a week full of lots of exciting learning and events ...

Maths

We have continued our focus on addition in math's this week. We have reminded ourselves how to count on (8 people on a bus and 4 more people get on. How many people are there now?) and particularly focussed on adding two distinct sets together.

Home learning: Can you bring counting into your daily lives. There are 2 plates and 2 cups, how many altogether?

Key Vocabulary: Sets, how many, altogether, counting, total.

This is a part-whole model.

We use this to help us add numbers together.

The whole number is at the top and the two parts at the bottom make the whole number.

Phonics

We have continued with our phase 3 phonics. This week we have learnt two new two phonemes (sounds) "ch" & "sh".


"ch" and "sh" are both digraph's, two letters that make one sound.

The children have been recognising and recalling the phase 2 and phase 3 sounds, blending the sounds to read words and we have even been holding sentences in our heads to independently write.

Home learning:

Ask your child what is a digraph? (two letters that make one sound).

When you are reading can your child find the digraphs?

We will definitely be doing more events soon.








We went on our walk to the post box. The children were very well behaved and walked super sensibly!
