Reception Class Weekly Newsletter

The Reception class have had an exciting week! We began our week visiting the library and I am super proud of the children's behaviour and manners during our visit. Well done Reception!

Maths

This week we have been learning how to **count on** to support our skill of addition. On Monday, Miss Smith used a puppet to count: Puppet says 1, children say 2, Puppet says 3, children say 4 and so on. We carried this on to 10. Then we changed the pattern. Puppet says 1, 2, children say 3, 4, Puppet says 5, 6, children say 7, 8.

After this, we counted on from 5. We knew that we had 5 fingers on one hand, so we made a fist and put 5 in our heads. Now, with 1 hand closed, we practiced adding on 1, 2, 3 or 4 using the fingers on the other hand. We continued our learning throughout the week using tens frames and counters to help us count on.

Home learning: Practice counting on at home.

"Put 5 in your head, what is 2 more than 5?"

"How many would we need to add to 5 to make 9?".

Phonics

We have continued with our phase 3 phonics. This week we have learnt three new phonemes (sounds) "ar" "or" & "ur".

Our new phonemes this week are all digraph's: two letters that make one sound.

The children have been recognising and recalling the phase 2 and phase 3 sounds, blending the sounds to read words and we have continued to hold sentences in our heads to independently write.


