Easter – Decorated Egg competition

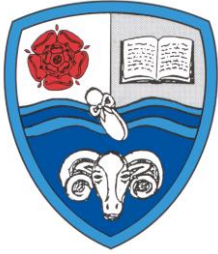
We will be holding our annual Easter egg decoration competition. Pupil can decorate a hard-boiled egg to enter the competition.

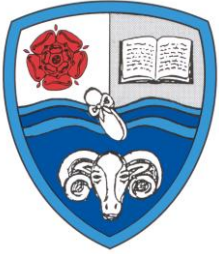
