
Reception class have had an exciting first week back following the school holiday.

Maths

We have been thinking about counting to and from 20, with a particular focus on the teen numbers.

We have been using Number Blocks to support our understanding, whilst thinking of what we know about each number.

For example, "15 is made of one ten and five", "Ten add five is fifteen", "fifteen is 5 more than 10".



Home learning:

Access NumBots and support your child's knowledge and understanding of math's as they explore and complete the different challenges.

Our core text this week was:



We began our new topic "Exploring England" thinking about the spring season.

We have been learning about and looking for key signs of spring, whilst discussing the changes we have noticed.

Phonics

This week we have learnt two new phonemes (sounds) "ear" & "air".

Our new phonemes this week are both **trigraph's:** three letters that make one sound.

The children have been:

- Recognising and recalling both phase 2 and phase 3 sounds.
- Blending the sounds to read words.
- Segmenting sounds to spell words.
- Reading a short sentence.
- Writing a short sentence.

Please read with your child.


