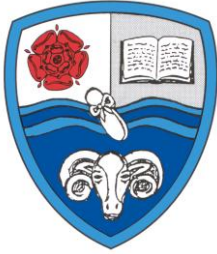

School places available

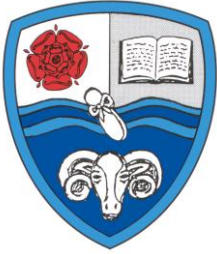
St Mary's CE Primary School have a small number of places available in some classes across the school.
