Parents are warmly welcomed to attend our weekly Friday celebration worships from 9am to 9:30am. This will take place in the school hall and can be attended via the school office main doors.

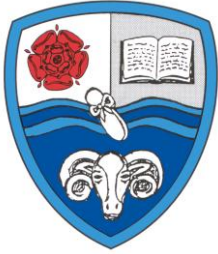

## **School places available**

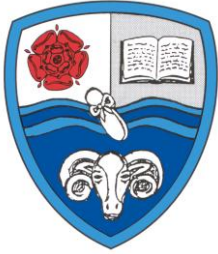
St Mary's CE Primary School have a small number of places available in some classes across the school.
