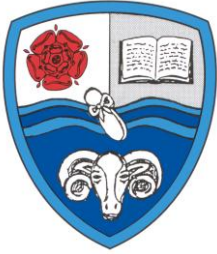
Join us on **Thursday 5th March** in celebrating

A tasty and nutritious breakfast, served in a warm and welcoming environment — all at no cost to families!

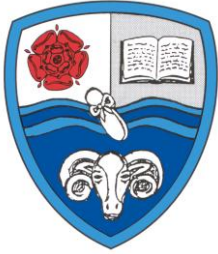
Why join?
