I would like to congratulate the children on a very positive parents evening and they should be very proud of their progress and achievements this term.

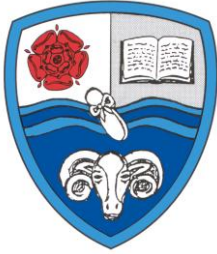
Thank you to all of the parents who completed the parent feedback survey. As a school we will now analyse these results and feedback and share this with you.

A tasty and nutritious breakfast, served in a warm and welcoming environment — all at no cost to families!

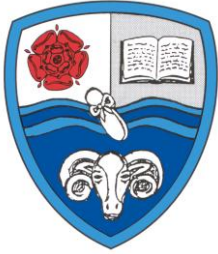
Why join?
