This will take place in the school hall and adults can attend via the school office main doors.

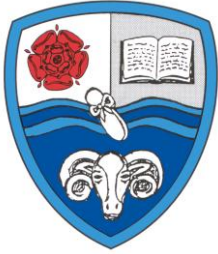

School places available

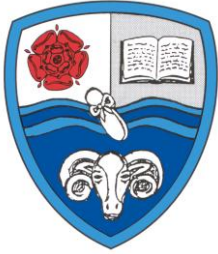
St Mary's CE Primary School have a small number of places available in some classes across the school.
