Friday Celebration Worship – Parents welcome

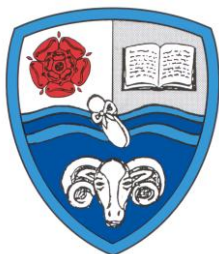
All parents and family members are warmly welcomed to attend our weekly Friday celebration worships from 9am to 9:30am.

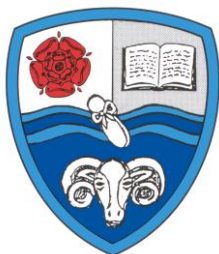
